1) **Bidwell Farmers' Market #2, Bidwell Park, 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.**

Start your day with a stroll through the idyllic Bidwell Farmers' Market, where performances from **Volver**, **David Adamczyk** and **Squawk the Show** will help you ease into one of the busiest days of the festival.

2) **"100 Drums Along Hoyt Lake," Delaware Park, 1 to 4:30 p.m.**

From Bidwell, it's a short stroll to picturesque Hoyt Lake in Delaware Park, where this expansive drumming event will take place, featuring performances from the Slyboots Drum Ensemble, Buffalo Percussion Collaborative, Brass Pro and the Waterfront Revivalists and many more.
